Performance Summary Overview


- all figures are baseline figures for first 12 months







Customer Satisfaction

 - · overall 71% average satisfaction









Health and Safety

Facility Management

- F360: 95.7% of scheduled inspections completed across the year
- Cleaning: 100% of planned cleaning tasks completed across the year
- PPM: 100% of scheduled PPM completed across all sites for the year
- key facility maintenance issues:
 - Parklands AHU: works commenced 30th April 8th May completion
 - Parklands moveable floor: currently investigating keeping the floor locked permanently at 0.9m - consultation with clubs and key groups to take place
 - Parklands plant: 3 x circulating pumps at parklands (replaced 1 and fixed 1) only had 1 pump at handover
 - Meadowlands Grounds Maintenance works ongoing as part of capital project
 - regular maintenance check with Council Officers and Fusion staff

 - Ivybridge GM:
 - Simon Smith the Business Manager now based at centre
 - Parklands GM:
 - Chris lamb Appointed in 2017
 - OCRA continue to provide a key Sports Development Partnership
- training and LMPD update
 - all staff have completed corporate induction
 - online training has 100% compliance
 - 4 team members entered on the ILM Management Training Programme level 4 & 5 - selection process for next round of Level 4 & 5 has just taken place - 6 candidates have been put forward
 - Fusion hosting swimming instructor courses in the district to encourage more uptake and meet the growing demand of our swim school
 - 25 Apprenticeships currently in the contract (Meadowlands: 5, Parklands: 7)


The first stage of work on the major refurbishment of Meadowlands is set to start from Microbay 4th December.



Quarterly Review

Capital Developments

Parklands:

- internal Ground floor improvement works complete
- new air con plant on order for first floor gym. Works commence 30/4/18 10 days
- first floor new spin studio works re-tendered pending contractor appointment, works commencing May 2018

Quayside:

- contractor appointed, started on site mid-April, Est. completion early Sept 2018
- project including pool side structural works

Ivybridge:

- works to start May 2018 tender process complete, waiting to appoint contractor
- start date: specific date to be confirmed with contractor (May/June 2018)
- scheduled completion date: early summer 2019 (12 month programme)

Totnes:

- phase 1: to commence May 2018, completion early June refurb of all common areas, gym redevelopment, 2 x first floor studios, replacing sauna & new pool filtration
- phase 2: developing scheme to include new turnstiles, reception, café and changing room improvements.
