Taxi stand Clifton Place Salcombe

I write concerning the proposal to appoint a stand for one taxi on Clifton Place Salcombe.

My property is in Clifton Place and would be impacted directly by the proposal.

I wish to make it clear that whilst I do not object, in principle to the proposal but I do object to the fact that vehicles of many descriptions including taxis do leave their Diesel engines running when stationary. This is unacceptable practice bearing in mind the effect of diesel emissions on persons and the environment.

I do understand that some of the vehicles using Clifton Place are refrigerated vehicles but the drivers leave their engines running for extended periods whilst making deliveries.

During the summer months, in particular we cannot open our windows on the street side because of diesel pollution.

I support the proposal on the clear condition that the Council takes action to prohibit the running of engines of all stationary vehicles when using and accessing Clifton Place.

I trust you will consider this representation in considering this proposal.
