## Hope and Anchor – variation to premises licence Amendments to application

The Applicant has agreed to make the following amendments to the premises licence application and to include additional conditions as listed below, following discussion with the Police:

- Removal of reference to 'bona fide guests'. The extensions requested for sale of alcohol and opening hours later at night will only apply to those residing at the premises overnight and will not include a 'guest' of a resident that is not staying on site.
- Under the 'protection of children from harm' objective, the following conditions to be included, in addition to those already on the premises licence:
  - If a young person who appears to staff to be 25 or under asks to purchase alcohol, they will be required to prove their age before they are served unless the staff are certain (from personal experience or because they have seen proof of age on a previous occasion) that the person is 18 or over
  - A notice advising customers that they may be required to prove their age before they can buy alcohol shall be displayed.
  - The forms of proof of age that will be accepted are a passport, photo' driving licence or a proof of age card bearing the "PASS" accreditation hologram
