The Police will be objecting with regard to the following Licensing Objectives

The premises is situated in a residential street close to houses and currently noise from smokers and persons leaving affect the lives of those residents.
An extra hour trading on a Saturday night will impact on those persons. Should the premises be granted this extra time it will impact greatly on the ability of the Police to respond to incidents. Not only at the premises but other areas as customers make their way home.
It is anticipated this extra time will mean customers will travel from further afield to attend thus causing noise when leaving and increasing the possibility of drink driving bearing in mind the limited availability of taxis.

There is also confusion re non standard times as per the application and the police would seek a decision by the committee for the benefit of all.

I would seek to produce Photos of the street showing the proximity of residential buildings
I intend to call a supervisory officer from Okehampton Police Station to give a policing overview
I intend at this time to use the services of the force legal department to present the representation.
