

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014

PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDERS (PSPO) COVERING PLAYING OF BALL GAMES

The South Hams District Council (in this Order called "the council") being satisfied that the conditions within Section 59 (2) and (3) of the above Act are met, do make the following order to control anti-social behaviour associated with the playing of ball games subject to the schedule below.

The PSPO area is defined as being the land described in the Schedule below and shown in purple on the maps attached to this Order, being land in the area of the Council.


This Order may be cited as the South Hams District Council Public Spaces Protection Order (Ball Games) 2018 and shall come into force on 1st January 2018.

SCHEDULE

If a person plays football or any other ball game, in the area known as Town Square and environs shown in purple on the attached map, which causes annoyance to a user of the Kingsbridge Quay, or others in the local area; and refuses to stop when requested by an authorised officer, they will have breached this order.
