

PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDERS (PSPO) COVERING ANTI-SOCIAL CAR USE

The South Hams District Council (in this Order called "the council") being satisfied that the conditions within Section 59 (2) and (3) of the above Act are met, do make the following order to control anti-social behaviour associated with the use of cars subject to the schedule below.

The PSPO area is defined as being the land described in the Schedule below and shown in yellow on the map attached to this Order, being land in the area of the Council.

This Order may be cited as the South Hams District Council Public Spaces Protection Order (Cars) 2018 and shall come into force on 1st January 2018.

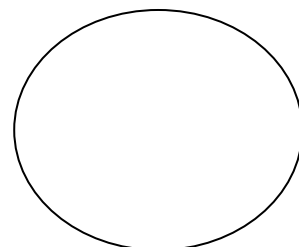
SCHEDULE

Under the terms of this Public Space Protection Order, the following is prohibited within the area; known as The Quay car park, outlined in yellow on the attached map:

- a) Gathering or loitering as part of a group around, or in, one or more stationary vehicles at any time, where such activity causes, or is likely to cause, noise, harassment, alarm or distress
- b) Engaging in, promoting, encouraging or assisting in activities of doughnuts, drifting or other driving-related nuisance causing, or likely to cause, danger, noise, harassment, alarm or distress to the public
- c) Causing or allowing excessive amplified music or other noise from vehicles such as to cause, or be likely to cause, alarm, harassment or distress as a result of a gathering in or around one or more vehicles
