Conditions agreed with Environmental Health

Environmental Health have agreed to withdraw their representation subject to the inclusion of the below conditions on the premises licence. We have received confirmation from the Applicant that they agree to these conditions being included.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

- No more than 120 guests shall be present during any event. Up to date records of the covers paid for shall be kept and maintained and made available for inspection by the Licensing Authority upon request.
- The commitments included in the Lighting Plan dated February 2023 (or succeeding revisions of this plan if agreed in writing by the Licensing Authority) shall be complied with at all times during any event.
- The commitments included within the Noise Management Plan dated April 2023 (or succeeding revisions of this plan if agreed in writing by the Licensing Authority) shall be complied with at all times during events at which live or amplified music is played.
- No amplified music shall be played on the premises in such a way that it is audible at the boundary of any nearby residence. Note: In this case "audible" is defined as the specific music noise level (measured as Laeq, 15 min) which exceeds the background noise level (measured as La90,15 min) prevailing at the time.
